MEMORANDUM FOR MARINE CORPS INVITEES

Subj: 18TH ANNUAL SEMPER FIDELIS GOLF CLASSIC

On 6 August 2004, the Marine Corps Reserve Association (MCRA) is hosting the 8th Annual MCRA Golf Tournament. Members of Congressional Staff, Department of Defense and other federal agencies, State and Local Government, industry, and private citizens will be in attendance. The event will include a breakfast, golf tournament, and award ceremony.

This memorandum constitutes a determination that attendance by Marine Corps personnel at the golf tournament qualifies as an exception under 5 C.F.R. 2635.204(g)(2). This memorandum also constitutes a blanket determination of agency interest under 5 C.F.R. 2635.204(g)(3)(ii). Accordingly, Marine Corps personnel whose duties do not substantially affect the Marine Corps Reserve Association may accept free attendance at the event, which includes the provision of food, refreshments and entertainment furnished to all attendees as an integral part of the event.

In addition, Marine Corps invitees may accept items from MCRA with a cumulative value of \$20.00 or less. This normally applies to a tournament's "goody bag", which includes items donated to the tournament's sponsor for distribution to the players. Marine Corps invitees may not accept prizes for tournament contests if the value of the prize exceeds \$20.00.

Marine Corps personnel whose duties may substantially affect the Marine Corps Reserve Association should seek an individual determination pursuant to 5 C.F.R. 2635.204(g)(3)(i) regarding this event from their local ethics counselor.
