

PENTAGON MEMORIAL

We need your immediate help to make the vision of the Pentagon Memorial a reality. This Memorial will commemorate the lives of the 184 people we lost at the Pentagon and place them individually into the larger context of the events of that tragic day. It will be funded entirely by private contributions; Congress has allowed DoD the authority to accept money, and Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld has authorized a one-time fundraising campaign to raise in **The Campaign's fund raising goal is in excess of \$1M**, to award the design-build contract and begin technical design work. The voluntary campaign will be effective until August 8, 2003. Contributions can be in the form of cash or check but not payroll deductions. All donations are tax deductible.
