Subj: Private Organizations On DoD Installations

Organizations on DoD Installations

1. Purpose. To provide for implementation of the policies and instructions contained in the enclosure.

2. Cancellation. MCO 5760.4A.

3. Action. Commanding generals and commanding officers will take action to implement the policies contained in the enclosure and the following instructions.

a. Civilian personnel membership in a private organization, except those type 1 private organizations defined in paragraph D1 of the enclosure as being exempted, is limited to not more than one-third of the total membership strength. This will maintain the private organization as an entity which is operated on the installation for the primary benefit of military personnel and their families. Civilian employees of the Department of Defense and members of military families may be included in the membership without regard to limitation.

b. The operation of small informal funds; i.e., office coffee funds, flower funds, and similar small informal activities and funds, as defined in paragraph D2 of the enclosure and this Order, may be established and operated as determined by the installation commander. Small informal funds are defined as any fund whose income is less than \$200 per month; i.e., office coffee messes or plaque funds. Any activity generating income in excess of this amount needs specific authorization from the commanding officer to operate aboard the base and must comply with all provisions of this Order. Coffee messes are not authorized to engage in the resale of food or other merchandise.

c. Direct financial assistance to a private organization from a nonappropriated fund instrumentality in any form is prohibited.
